



Three Double Wide Trailers for the Base

to a *full* lot!**

God has blessed us with three double wide trailers for the base. We are moving forward with all the required paperwork to get the six permits we need. We have submitted applications for, construction permits for a 36' by 60' pole barn, construction permits for



a 36' by 36' pole barn, a placement permit for a 28' by 70' double wide trailer, a placement permit for 24' by 64' double wide, a RV cover permit and a permit for the existing 3 car garage that was on the property when we purchased it. We have completed the gopher study, Oregon spotty frog study and the wetlands study. We have also submitted the wetlands study to Thurston County Planning Division for review. Upon review of all our paperwork, all six requests should be approved at one time. We need to raise funds to do the actual remodel of the double wide trailers on the property. Currently, we have received all the funding to move all three and \$1,580 towards the remodel. We need to raise \$33,320.00 to complete Phase 1. This phase consists of bringing in new electricity at a cost of \$12,700.00, and remodeling costs of approximately \$20,000.00 to meet Thurston County requirements. We have been asking God how to make this a reality. Recently, a friend of the ministry pledged a dollar for dollar donation up to \$10,000 to start the move and remodel of the mobile homes. If we find others to join us in this incredible opportunity, FHH-YWAM can have a great start toward our Phase 1 completion. Will you consider helping today? Your gift will be a blessing for many generations to come, because of this God-given opportunity! Please, do it now. Time is short and this opportunity will end by January 2018. Will you join us in sharing food and the life-giving hope of Jesus to those we serve?
